1. PA Wing CAC Elections

All Groups are expected to send their Chair, Vice Chair, and Recorder to all future Wing CAC Meetings starting with the 17 March meeting. If a Group does not yet have a CAC, they should be elected from the Squadron representatives ASAP and then are expected to attend the Cadet Conference on 28 April. At the Cadet Conference, a new Wing CAC will be elected from the Group representatives to serve from April 2012–April 2013. Please note that no cadet may attend Wing CAC without the permission of their Squadron and Group Commander.

2. PA Wing Cadet Competition 2012

The Cadet Competition will take place on Sunday, March 25, 2012 at Penn State University, College Park. Six squadrons are currently registered: 602, 904, 811, 603, 239, and 338. The cadets will be judged by USAF and PA ANG members.

3. PA Wing Cadet Conference 2012

The Cadet Conference will be held on April 28, 2012 at the REOTS Center at Fort Indiantown Gap. Registration materials are available under Cadet Programs on the PA Wing website. Our special guest this year is Mary Feik, Colonel, CAP. Any cadets who have obtained the Feik achievement within the last few months may have it presented by her during the banquet. Also, any cadets who have obtained milestone awards since the Wing Conference may have their award presented at the Wing Conference. All awards must be framed and either delivered to Wing HQ by mail by 26 April or hand carried to the conference on the 28th.
