Courses Offered

Basic Course: Designed to cover all navigation skills from beginner through the Ranger 2nd Class and Ground Team Member Level 2. Classroom instruction is supplemented by practical field exercises. Intense navigation classes and exercises combined with Search and Rescue Applications.

Advanced Course: Covers navigation skills from Ranger 1st Class and Advanced Ranger. Review of all basic navigation, UTM, aeronautical navigation including VOR and plotting terminal approaches.

Aircrew Survival: Egress Training, Initial Survival Concerns, CAP Aircraft Survival Kit, The WILL to Survive, Improvising Equipment, Communication – Signaling, Land Navigation, First Aid - Personal Hygiene, Nutrition - Water Procurement, Basic Survival Skills for all Regions, Shelter - Weather - Fire Building, Practical experience of survival
