



“Hawk Mountain Ranger School is a tremendous asset that all CAP Members should be using.”

The Hawk Mountain Ranger School is located in southeastern Pennsylvania, in Berks County, 5 miles northeast of Hamburg, on Pine Swamp Road. 40° 37' 31" N 75° 56' 35" W. This CAP corporate property is seventy-seven acres near the Hawk Mountain Bird Sanctuary and the Appalachian Trail, which runs through the training

area. The training area is operated, maintained & managed by Ranger Staff of the Pennsylvania Wing, Civil Air Patrol.

There are plenty of camping and hiking spaces, navigation course, obstacle course, parade field, crash sites, pole buildings and classrooms.
