



CAPR39-1 dated 23 March 2005 and modified by CAP/CC Letter dated 25 January, 2008, is supplemented as follows:

Table 2-3, Item 6. Men's and Women's Battle Dress Uniforms

1. **Added.** When wearing the woodland BDU's, the only authorized headgear for all flights, squadrons, and groups chartered under the Pennsylvania Wing is the orange baseball hat. **EXCEPTION:** The blue baseball hat, with the PA Wing Staff insignia embroidered on the front, is authorized for wear by members of the PA Wing who are assigned to PA001 charter. PA Wing HQ members may wear the orange baseball hat when performing ES duties as appropriate to their ES position (i.e. Ground Team Leader, Ground Branch Director, etc.). The above headgear will be worn appropriately in accordance with CAPM 39-1.
2. **Added.** Flights and squadrons will display their respective three or four digit numbers on the front of the orange hats. Numbers will be black, and 2 inches in height. They may be felt material, embroidered, or silk-screened upon the front. Placement of the numbers will be centered across the front of the hat ½ inch above the visor. Group HQ's may display the following identification upon their covers; GP1, GP2, GP3, GP4, GP5, GP6, and GP800. Group HQ's may also display a distinct emblem on the front of the covers (i.e. Group Insignia, etc.) upon the approval of the PA Wing Commander.
3. **Added.** Hawk Mountain Ranger School Staff will wear the orange baseball hat with the keystone emblem affixed to the front in place of standard unit numbers. The Keystone will be 2 ¼ to 2 ½ inches in height and will be placed ½ inch above the visor, centered on the front. The black keystone will be worn by all Hawk Mountain Staff members who have earned the achievement of Instructor or Expert Ranger. The red keystone, with black border will be worn by all other Hawk Mountain Staff members. These hats are to be worn only at Hawk Mountain Ranger School Events. Hawk Mountain Ranger School Students will wear the orange baseball hat with their respective unit number or the HMRS logo.
4. **Added.** PA Wing Encampment or School staff will wear the orange baseball hat with ENC, CLS, LDC, PFE or GFE in place of the standard unit numbers. The placement and presentation of these numbers will be the same as those prescribed for flights, and squadrons.
5. **Added.** In accordance with "Changes to CAPM 39-1" (25 January 2008, NHQ) grade insignia is not authorized for wear with the CAP baseball hat. **EXCEPTION:** Senior and cadet metal grade insignia is to be worn with the Hawk Mountain Keystone baseball hat, as authorized by NHQ.
6. **Added.** The Wing Commander may permit exceptions to this memorandum in order to perform certain duties, or requirements (i.e. distinct baseball hats for the SAR Competitions, encampments, etc.). Any authorized deviations from this memorandum will be in accordance with CAPM 39-1.
7. **Added.** IAW CAPM 39-1, Table 1-3, Line 2, any PA Wing distinctive headgear will be worn within the boundaries of the Pennsylvania Wing only, and may not be worn to activities

outside of Pennsylvania unless otherwise approved by the Wing Commander where the activity is taking place.

Table 2-3, Line 12. Men's and Women's Battle Dress Uniforms

1. **Added.** In accordance with CAPM 39-1, Table 2-3, Line 12, the authorized T-shirt color with the BDU uniform is brown or black. In addition, Pennsylvania Wing members are authorized to wear an orange T-shirt for emergency services missions or training. Orange T-Shirts are not to be worn for normal squadron meetings or as standard wear with BDU's.
2. **Added.** T-Shirts with a squadron PT Uniform may be of a differing color and design, but may only be worn as part of the PT Uniform and not with the BDU or any other uniform.
3. **Added.** In accordance with CAPM 39-1, Figure 4-5, Line 10, the CAP distinctive utility uniform (blue utility uniform) authorizes the wear of white T-shirts. PA Wing members are authorized to wear the orange T-shirt with the distinctive blue utility uniform in accordance with item #1 above.
4. **Added.** IAW CAPM 39-1, Table 1-3, Line 2, any PA Wing distinctive T-Shirts will be worn within the boundaries of the Pennsylvania Wing only, and may not be worn outside of Pennsylvania unless otherwise approved by the Wing Commander where the activity is taking place.
5. **Added.** Authorized breast insignia for T-shirts are the CAP seal, Counter Drug Emblem, Ranger Staff, Squadron Patch, or other school insignias as authorized by the Wing Commander. Any other, emblems, insignias and logos must be approved by the Wing Commander.

Table 4-6, Line 5. Men's and Women's CAP Utility Uniform

1. **Added.** When wearing the blue utility uniform (BBDU), the only authorized headgear for all flights, squadrons, and groups chartered under the Pennsylvania Wing is the orange baseball hat. **EXCEPTION:** The blue baseball hat, with the PA Wing Staff insignia embroidered on the front, is authorized for wear by members of the PA Wing who are assigned to PA001 charter. PA Wing HQ members may wear the orange baseball hat when performing ES duties as appropriate to their ES position (i.e. Ground Team Leader, Ground Branch Director, etc.). The above headgear will be worn appropriately in accordance with CAPM 39-1.
2. **Added.** Wear of the orange CAP baseball hat with the BBDU will follow guidelines set forth above for proper wear with the Men's and Women's Battle Dress Uniforms.
3. **Added.** The Wing Commander may permit exceptions to this memorandum in order to perform certain duties, or requirements (i.e. distinct baseball hats for the SAR Competitions, encampments, etc.). Any authorized deviations from this memorandum will be in accordance with CAPM 39-1.
4. **Added.** IAW CAPM 39-1, Table 1-3, Line 2, any PA Wing distinctive headgear will be worn within the boundaries of the Pennsylvania Wing only, and may not be worn to activities outside of Pennsylvania unless otherwise approved by the Wing Commander where the activity is taking place.

Table 4-6, Line 3. Men's and Women's CAP Utility Uniform

1. **Added.** In accordance with CAPM 39-1, Table 4-6, Line 3, the authorized T-shirt color with the blue utility uniform (BBDU) is white. In addition, Pennsylvania Wing members are authorized to wear an orange T-shirt for emergency services missions or training. Orange T-Shirts are not to be worn for normal squadron meetings or as standard wear with blue utility uniform (BBDU).
2. **Added.** T-Shirts with a squadron PT Uniform may be of a differing color and design, but may only be worn as part of the PT Uniform and not with the BBDU or any other uniform.
3. **Added.** IAW CAPM 39-1, Table 1-3, Line 2, any PA Wing distinctive T-Shirts will be worn within the boundaries of the Pennsylvania Wing only, and may not be worn outside of Pennsylvania unless otherwise approved by the Wing Commander where the activity is taking place.

This supplement is in effect as of the date listed above and supersedes all other Pennsylvania Wing supplements and policies on the subject.
