



OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CIVIL AIR PATROL VEHICLES

CAPR 77-1 dated 26 December 2012 (Includes Change 1, 31 July 2013) is supplemented as follows:

Added: Section 1-5b

1. PA Wing has partnered with the Pennsylvania Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to access driver records for processing CAP driver licenses. This service is available to Wing LGT staff at no charge.
 - a. Effective 1 June 2012, PA Wing will transition to processing licenses within eServices.
 - b. Licenses generated by the PA Wing License System prior to 1 June 2012 will remain valid until they expire. All renewals will be made through the eServices process.
 - c. License submissions made after 1 June 2012 will be initiated by the member in eServices Ops Quals by submitting *only one of the following forms*:
 - i. Pa Department of Motor Vehicles DL503 available on the Logistics section of the Wing website at <http://pawg.cap.gov>
 - ii. Member furnished drivers record.
 - d. Member furnished drivers records must be dated less than 30 days from the date of eServices submission.

Added: Section 5-1b

1. PA Wing will upload a scanned copy of the CAPF 73 each month when entering their vehicle time and usage into ORMS.
